Keep trusting God with what He has placed in your hands. The seeds you plant today through prayer, faith, and intentional leadership will impact generations to come. And when the time comes to release your children, may your prayers help them fly swift and true, finding their mark for the glory of God.

How to Use This Guide

We created this guide to help you pray intentionally and confidently over your children using God's Word. Each day includes three passages of scripture to build your prayers from, prompts to guide your focus, and a written prayer to help you begin. Use these as a starting point, then allow the Holy Spirit to lead you as you pray for your children.

Pray it by Name

When you find a scripture, make it personal. Say your child's name out loud. Pray it over them as your own, trusting that God's promises never fail and never return void. For example:

"Jackson is Your dear son, Your darling child.

You remember him even when You discipline him in love.

Your heart yearns for Jackson, Lord, and You will surely have mercy on him" (adapted from Jeremiah 31:20).

The A.S.K. Method

If you would like guidance as you study the Word, we invited you to use the A.S.K. method.

Ask

Invite God to speak and prepare your heart.

Seek

Slow down and study the scripture more deeply:

- Scripture - Select a verse or passage to focus on
- Extract - Extract key words, phrases, or themes
- Examine - Examine them using tools like cross-references, concordances or commentaries
- Key Takeaways - Write down the truths God is revealing

Knock

Respond in prayer. Apply what God is showing you and pray it over your child.

Presence

Father,

When they face rejection, anxiety, or uncertainty, remind them that You are near. Do not let the enemy convince them they are forgotten or unseen. Anchor them in the truth that You are with them wherever they go.

Fill them with Your Holy Spirit and give them power to live for You. Help them recognize Your voice clearly and follow it with confidence.

Give them courage to stand firm in their faith and to live boldly in every environment You place them in. Let them not shrink back, but walk in the strength that comes from You. Empower them to be a witness for Jesus.

Go before them and give them rest. When life feels heavy, teach them to trust You and find peace in Your presence.

Let them live secure in knowing they are fully known, fully loved, and never alone.

Psalm 1:3

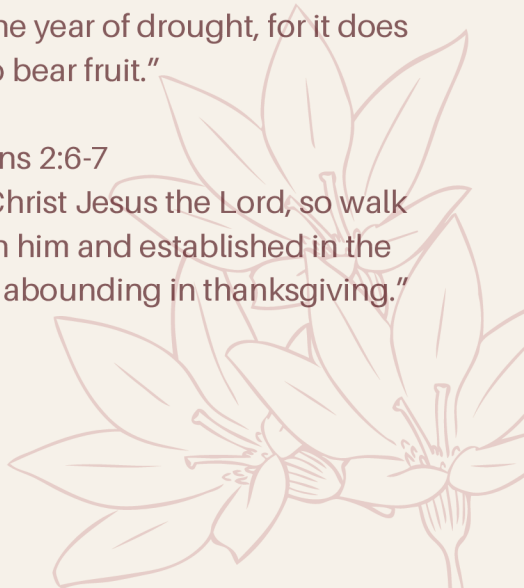

John 14:27

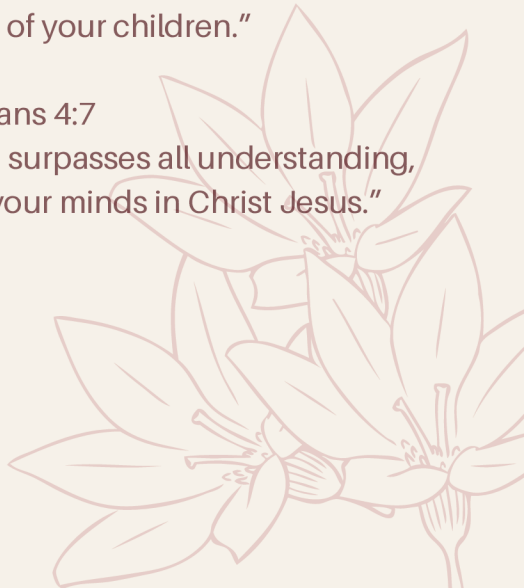

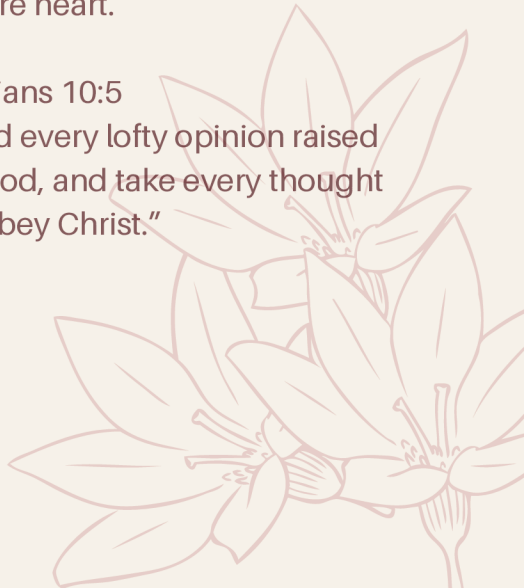

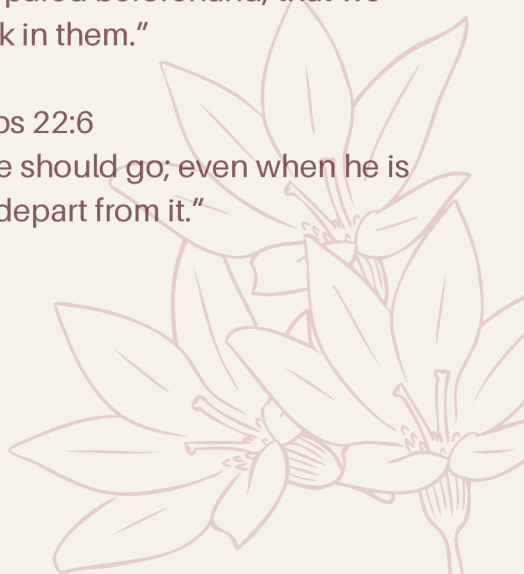

Psalm 145:3-4

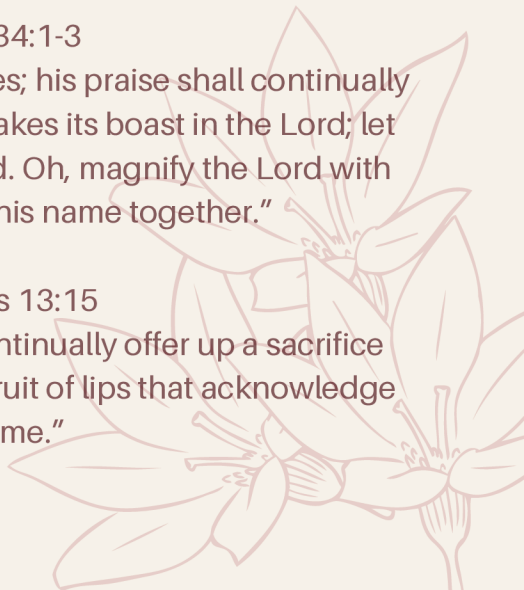
"Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised, and his greatness is unsearchable. One generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts."

Psalm 91:11

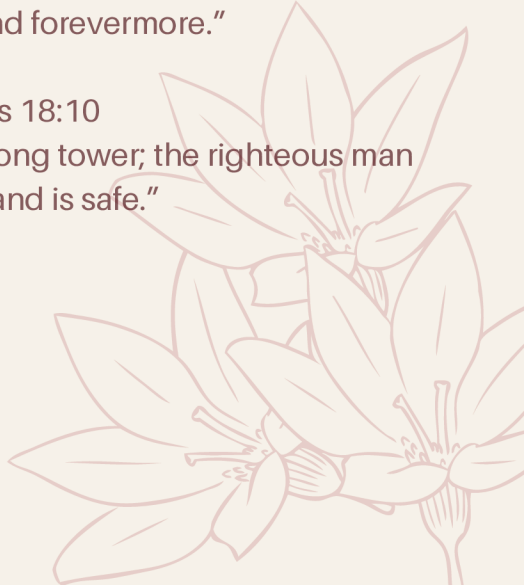
